## Accommodation

## **The Golf Courses**

### **Gulf Harbour**

This is a great layout to rival any international course. The resort hosted the prestigious World Cup in 1998. Designed by Robert Trent Jones, who likens it to the illustrious Pebble Beach in California, the course played host to the 2005 Holden New Zealand Open where Niclas Fasth of Sweden beat many of the world's top golfers. It also played host to the Blue Chip NZ Open in November 2006. The 35km drive north of Auckland will take about 45 minutes.



### **The Grange**

The Grange is widely regarded as one of New Zealand's iconic golf courses that is always immaculately presented and is an excellent test of golf. Visitors from around the world are made welcome, and the course has hosted every major New Zealand Golf Tournament, both Amateur and Professional, including the New Zealand Open Championship on 8 occasions.

### **Titirangi Golf Club**

Titirangi is a world-class golf course situated in a beautiful bushland setting between the lower slopes of the Waitakere Ranges and the Manukau Harbour. Founded in 1909, it is a private members club but offers limited playing opportunities for New Zealand and overseas visitors.

Titirangi is ranked as one of New Zealand's top courses and is the only one in the country designed by Dr. Alister MacKenzie. MacKenzie's designs are notable for their sensitivity to the nature of the original site and he is admired for producing holes that offer an ideal balance of risk and reward. After designing Titirangi in 1927, MacKenzie went on to design some of the world's top courses including Augusta, Cypress Point and Royal Melbourne.



## **Transport**

### **Mercedes Sprinter**

You will be supplied one of our own 7 or 12 seat executive Mercedes rental vehicles. They are all late models with comfortable leather seats. These vehicles are perfectly designed with the golfers and equipment in mind.
