Golf Courses

Jacks Point: With a back drop of 2,300 vertical metres of the Razorback Remarkables mountain range and an armchair view of an outstanding lake and mountain panorama, Jacks Point golf course is not only one of the most spectacular in the world, but as an 18 hole par 72 championship course it offers golfers of any calibre a challenging and unforgettable experience.

Millbrook: Play on one of the most scenic golf courses in the world at Millbrook. Dwarfed by the surrounding mountain ranges of The Remarkables and Coronet Peak, the dramatic terrain challenges all levels of players. Offering five different tee positions, the original 27-hole course designed by Sir Bob Charles has been significantly upgraded, with additions including a stunning new nine holes by former touring pro Greg Turner. The new 'Coronet Nine' gives players the choice of playing any two of the three nines at one time.

Arrowtown: The picturesque Arrowtown Golf Club is set in one of New Zealand's most historic and scenic regions. This Golf Course is a must play when visiting Queenstown, surrounded by mountains the 18 hole course has superb views from every fairway. Each hole has its own attraction and the diverse and challenging course attracts players from all over the world. Historic stone cottage ruins nestle amongst towering trees, a legacy of Arrowtown's pioneers.

Queenstown Golf Club (Kelvin Heights): This is the course that thousands of visitors view from their hotel balconies! Located on the Kelvin Heights Peninsular and surrounded by the clean waters of the Lake Wakatipu the Queenstown Golf Club is internationally regarded as one of the more picturesque golf courses in the world.

Wanaka: The Wanaka Golf Course is a picturesque 18 hole golf course surrounded by mountains, overlooking the lake, nestled above the township of Wanaka. Course maintenance is of a very high standard here and as Central Otago continues to grow as a golfing destination so too does Wanaka Golf Club. Wanaka is approximately one hour from Queenstown by road.

The Hills: The Hills was designed by Darby Partners and opened in 2007 to host the New Zealand Open. Set over 500 acres of land across a glacial valley, The Hills is home to an incredible array of flora including native brown top grasses and wild native mountain tussocks. Sculptures crafted by New Zealand artists compliment the natural beauty of the course's lakes, waterways and wetland areas. Winter snow and frost conditions provide the ideal climate for the finest grasses suited to the modern day game of golf.
